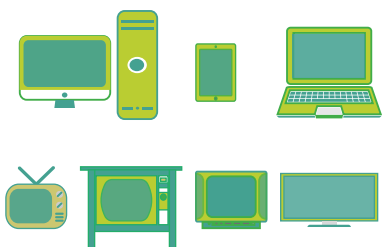

ITEMS THAT WILL BE ACCEPTED

Processing fees apply to certain items. **CASH ONLY.**

Please be prepared to pay at event entrance. Bring exact change.



ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT: DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers and computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, keyboards, tablet computers, and e-readers.



TELEVISION SETS: TV sets encased in plastic, sets encased in wood, big screen TV sets, and projection TV sets (**no charge**).



TIRES: Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 extra tires off rim. \$3 for each passenger tire on a rim. \$9 for each large truck tire, and \$18 for each truck tire on rim. No oversized tires accepted.



BATTERIES: Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle. Led-acid, AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries. Also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cell phone batteries.



CARDBOARD: Flattened. No wax coated cardboard.



PROPANE TANKS: Residential tanks only. \$5 charge.



PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS: Remove toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings. \$15.



REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS/AIR CONDITIONERS: \$30 per refrigerator or freezer. \$35 for each household air conditioner.



APPLIANCES/SCRAP METAL: House hold appliances. auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), metal lawn chairs, barbecues, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and non-ferrous metals. \$5 (cash only) will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating.



MATTRESS/BOX SPRINGS: Mattresses and box springs any size. \$15 each. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.



STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS: No urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, expanded polypropylene or foam insulation. Keep the packing peanuts in a box or bag. Materials must be clean and dry.



DOCUMENT SHREDDING: Limit 4 file-size boxes.

PLEASE NOTE: HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to donation locations in the local area. CALL FIRST TO CONFIRM LOCATIONS ARE OPEN AND ACCEPTING MATERIAL.

Bulky yard debris and scrap wood will not be collected at this event. Bulky yard debris and scrap wood will be collected at a similar event next spring.

No flat beds or dump trucks allowed. We reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.
