

Upgrade Your Mailbox There are a lot of options out there! A solid, locking mailbox may discourage thieves from even trying or prevent them from getting in.

Pick up mail promptly Don't leave it in your mailbox overnight. If you are expecting checks, credit cards or other valuable items, ask a friend or neighbor to pick up your mail.

If you are going out of town, tell the Post Office and they can hold your mail until you return.

Sign up for INFORMED DELIVERY. You can see photos of your mail before it arrives – for free! This way you know what is missing in the event your mail does get stolen. Go onto the USPS website and sign up!

Don't send cash in the mail.



Deposit mail in a mail slot in the post office, at a Postal Service mailbox, or hand it to your letter carrier.
